A1. APPLICATION

100. Application

101. The present Title 44 applies to every special purpose ship of not less than 500 gross tonnage certified on or after 13 May 2008.

102. RBNA may also apply these provisions as far as reasonable and practicable to special purpose ships of less than 500 gross tonnage and to special purpose ships constructed before 13 May 2008.

103. This Title 44 does not apply to ships meeting the Code for the Construction and Equipment of Mobile Offshore Drilling Units (MODU Code).

104. This Title 44 is not intended for ships used to transport and accommodate industrial personnel that are not working on board.

100. Stability and subdivision

101. The documents required in Part II, Title 21, Section 7 are to be submitted.

CHAPTER E ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS

100. General

101. the requirements of part D of Part II, Title 21, Section 7 (chapter II-1 of SOLAS) should be met.

200. Precautions against shock, fire and other hazards of electrical origin

201. All installations should be in accordance with regulation 45.1 to 45.10 inclusive of part D of chapter II-1 of SOLAS.

202. Installations on special purpose ships carrying more than 60 persons on board should also be in accordance with regulation 45.11 of part D of chapter II-1 of SOLAS

300. Emergency source of power

301. Installations in special purpose ships carrying not more than 60 persons on board should be in accordance with regulation 43 of part D of chapter II-1 of SOLAS and in addition special purpose ships of more than 50 m in length should meet the requirements of regulation 42.2.6.1 of that part.
